BRIGADIER HURST MEMORIAL TROPHY

The Brigadier G. S. Hurst Memorial Trophy, for Most Successful Red Poll Prime Steer Exhibitor, is open to all breeders and fatteners of Red Poll or Red Poll Cross Cattle in Australia. National Executive shall present prize money for the highest aggregate of points scored by exhibitors in ALL BREED Steer and Carcase Competitions throughout Australia - first prize \$100, and second prize \$25. In addition, the winner of first prize shall receive a medallion/trophy to the value of \$25.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- i. Competition is limited to All Breed steer and carcase competitions (not Red Poll classes alone).
- All steer and carcase competitions throughout Australia are eligible providing there are a minimum of ii twenty animals in the competition, and
 - 1) There are not less than six exhibits in single classes;
 - 2) There are not less than four exhibits in pens of two or three;
 - 3) There are not less than three exhibits in pens of five;
 - 4) There are not less than two exhibits in pens of nine or more;
- iii. 1) Points will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class as defined in item (ii).

2) Champion and Reserve Champion points will be awarded provided there are a minimum of two classes in the competitions as defined in item (ii).

3) Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion points will be awarded providing there are a minimum of two champions as defined in (iii) 2) competing for the award and it is judged the Best Steer or Carcase of the Show.

- The competition is run over a calendar year. Entries are to be submitted to the iv. Federal Secretary before the 31st January of the year following the competition.
- Point Score: v.

1). Hoof: Grand Champion, 20; Reserve Grand Champion, 10; Champion 10; Reserve Champion 5; Class placing 1st, 5, 2nd, 3; 3rd, 1.

2). Hook: Grand Champion, 80; Reserve Grand Champion, 40; Champion, 40;

Reserve Champion, 20; Class Placing 1st, 20; 2nd, 10; 3rd, 5.

1 point for every steer exhibited in competitions as defined in items (i) and (ii).
